COUNTDOWN TO GRADUATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION CANDIDATES MUST:

Review your degree requirements with your advisor.

Submit your degree application to the Office of the Registrar. A \$112 graduation fee will be assessed for CAS graduates. Graduates who are in the Doctoral Program and COP, will be assessed a \$138 fee. Graduate Program students will be assessed \$112 graduate fee (M Ed.). Make sure the application is complete and accurate.

Complete an Exit Interview with Financial Aid.

Students must satisfy all financial obligations to Xavier University (Student Accounts, Library Fines, Parking Tickets, Student Health Services) in order to participate in the May, 2018 Commencement Ceremony, receive a diploma and obtain an official academic transcript. The deadline for satisfying financial obligations **in order to participate in the Commencement Ceremony** is April 28, 2018.

Students currently enrolled at another institution must submit an official transcript to the Office of the Registrar, no later than May 2, 2018. If you plan to register for any CLEP exams, you must do so by March 31, 2018.

Visit the XU Bookstore for graduation cap/gown measurements.

If you are not participating in commencement, submit a "Letter of Absentia" along with a fee of \$30.00 to the Registrar's Office immediately. In absentia graduates are ineligible for Admission Tickets.

Update your current and permanent addresses and phone numbers in the Registrar's Office or on Banner Web.

DIPLOMAS

DIPLOMAS are awarded at the Commencement Exercises to those who have satisfied ALL requirements for the degree and whose fiscal accounts are clear. Please confirm name change, spelling, etc. with the Office of the Registrar. If you completed your work last summer or fall and are now out of town, or if for other grave reasons you will be unable to be present for the Commencement Exercises, you must request permission to receive your degree in absentia. This should be done as soon as possible, if you have not already done so. Be sure to include in your letter of request to you College Dean's Office, the address to which the diploma should be mailed. There is an additional \$31 fee for diplomas in absentia (Total graduation fee \$144 for College of Arts & Sciences and \$169 for College of Pharmacy.)

COMMENCEMENT ENTRANCE/ACCESS

Commencement Entrance and seating for the general public at the Convocation Center will be on a first-come, first-served basis. ALL GUESTS MUST HAVE A TICKET TO ENTER. Doors open at 9:00 a.m. We strongly suggest that your guests arrive early, but not later than 9:45 a.m.

At the completion of the Commencement ceremony, guests are directed to meet graduates outside of the entrance to the Convocation Center. **ALL GUESTS ARE ASKED TO WAIT OUTSIDE IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFUSION. THANK YOU!**
