Petar Tchouhov is a poet from Sofia, Bulgaria, who has published eleven collections of poetry, a novel, a collection of short stories and a children's book. His works have been translated into eighteen languages and included in many newspapers, journals and anthologies in Bulgaria and abroad. He plays guitar in rock bands, writes music and lyrics. He has performed his poetry and music at festivals and other events in Japan, USA, Russia, Switzerland, Germany, Hungary, Croatia, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia, and Macedonia. He is the winner of the top

prize at the 61st Bashi Festival in Japan and many others. Recently, he has been performing his poetry with the spoken rock band LaTeX and has been playing also in the bands Gologan and Par Avion Band. You can listen to his music on Youtube.
