**Objective:** Xavier University of Louisiana’s Department of Computer Science extends an invitation to our *CS: Exploring Computer Science at Xavier* summer program (CSSP).

CS: Exploring Computer Science at XU is a two-week non-residential program designed to enrich the computation-specific studies of high school students through computational problem-solving tasks in exciting and engaging ways. We’ll explore computer science and solve problems by designing and creating Android mobile apps, programming robots to perform tasks that we want, even explore the creative side of computer science using Google’s Cardboard for virtual reality projects. We’ll have many challenges and competitions where students can win prizes and recognition by doing their best.

**When:** May 30th - June 10th 2016, weekdays from 9:00am until noon.

**Who:** Current 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders. We look forward to exploring science with all kinds of students: high-achieving, typical, funny, quiet, nervous, those interested in science, those who aren’t sure if they’re interested in science, and even those who think they’re not interested in science.
