Our Program

The entry level PharmD program is designed for students to earn their Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 6 years, which includes one year of experiential training. Students acquire knowledge in physical, chemical, biological & behavioral sciences, and management with clinical components. Skills in drug therapy, drug distribution, & patient communication are also learned.

Admission Requirements

- Preferred GPA of 2.75
- Math/Science GPA of 2.75
- PharmCAS Application & documents
- No GRE, MCAT, or PCAT scores

Pre-requisite courses include: Chemistry I & II, Organic Chemistry I & II, Physics, Biology I & II, Microbiology, Calculus, Biostatistics, Health Ethics, Theology, English I & II, Public Speaking, plus Psychology or Sociology.
